Israel in Numbers

03

- Ropulation: about 8.5 million
- Working-age population: about 5 million
- Rate of people with disabilities at working-age: **24.7**%
- Rate of disability allowances recipients at working-age: 5.5%

Half **median** net cash household income, adjusted for family size

Readcount):



Represented Services Poverty severity (FGT):


FGT

=income gap of Hh_i = $(z-y_i)/z$, y_i = net income of Hh_i = earnings + benefits + pensions, δ = inequality aversion (of social planner)


Poverty Rate: General households vs. Households with disabilities




People with Disabilities by Impairments




Deviation from Poverty Rate by Impairment





Live Alone: General Households vs Households with Disabilities




Poverty Rate: Live Alone vs. Not Alone




Deviation from Poverty Rate by Severity of Disability




Amount of Monthly Disability Allowances




Employment Rate: Population vs. Disability Allowance Recipients



% Change in Employment Rates: Population vs. Disability Allowance Recipients




Employment Rate by Impairments




Employment Rate by Impairments: 2003-2014




Average Salaries by Impairments




Correlation between relative poverty ratio and income

Conclusion

- Poverty incidence of PWD is higher than for the general poor, but poverty severity tends to be less for them.
- PWD are more likely to live alone and lonely people have higher poverty rate than others.
- The poverty rates vary, based on the type of impairment. They are highest for the intellectually impaired and lowest for the neurologically impaired.
- If we exclude 'functioning-benefits' (fb, no substitution) in the PWD's income definition then ranking changes, but if fb are really cost refunds then ranking changes.
- The more severe the disability, the greater is the amount of benefits and the lower is the likelihood of being poor.
- Representation of the property of the PWD work less and are less educated, but their employment ratio increases faster.
